

Items you can typically recycle:

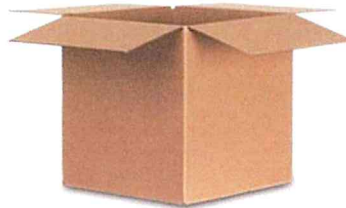
Cardboard recycling

Did you know greasy pizza boxes are not recyclable?

You can also include newspaper inserts, catalogs, paperback books, phone books and brochures.

Acceptable Items

- Ream wrappers
- File folders
- Poster board
- Cardboard boxes (broken down)



Plastic recycling

Did you know recycling just ten plastic bottles will save enough energy to power a laptop for more than 25 hours?

Recycle plastics #1 through 7. Look at the bottom of containers for a number inside the recycling arrows.

Acceptable Items

- Milk jugs – only plastic (no cartons)
- Water/Soda containers
- Shampoo/Soap/Detergent bottles.



Aluminum/Metal recycling

Did you know recycling just one ton of aluminum cans conserves more than 1,024 gallons of gasoline?

Recycle all food and beverage metal cans - steel, tin, bi-metal, and aluminum.

Acceptable Items

- Aluminum beverage cans
- Food cans (must be rinsed out)
- Scrap metal



Glass recycling*

Did you know glass is not recyclable in all areas? Make sure to check with your local team.

Recycle clear and colored glass.

Acceptable Items

- Beverage containers (must be rinsed out)
- Glass food jars (must be rinsed out)
